

Plants of the Ōki Islands retain characteristics connected to the main island of Japan. Usually their climate, but plants from both cold and warm. This is due to the sea level falling during the last ice age, the main island of Japan and allowing plants to Retain Geopark Site. *Schizocodon tomentosus* Japanese Cedar, *Chiricugi* Japanese Cypress, *Shizen-kaki-no-mori* Forest
